

Nursing: Transfer Graduation Plan for Success (GPS)



Sample Plan: Full-time Student with Developmental Education

This transfer GPS prepares students to pursue a four-year degree in Nursing at a Florida public university or Florida College System (FCS) institution. Courses listed are common prerequisites for a nursing major at the bachelor's level and will satisfy the general education and elective credits within Eastern Florida State College's A.A. degree program. Adjust your pace to graduation by taking more or less classes each term, attending year-round or taking modularized developmental education courses.
