Priority Financial Aid Application Deadline - Thursday, April 22, 2021

EFSC must receive the 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and all other required documentation by 4/22/21 to notify students of eligibility prior to the Fee Due Date. Complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov using EFSC's school code of 001470 and monitor the Message Center in [myEFSC](#) and your student email for additional documentation requests. It can take the Department of Education 3-5 days to process a FAFSA before they send it to EFSC and some students must obtain documentation from the IRS that can take up to 10 days to receive, so apply ASAP! Use of the IRS Data Retrieval Tool within the FAFSA is highly recommended. **The last day to submit the 2020-21 FAFSA is June 30, 2021.**

Pell Recalculation Date - Thursday, May 20, 2021 *****IMPORTANT!*****

Only classes required for your current program of study at EFSC are included in determining enrollment levels for grants. **REGISTRATION & FAFSA RECEIVED BY 5/20/21:** If EFSC has received your FAFSA and you are registered for any part of term on 5/20/21, that enrollment will be used to recalculate your eligibility for Pell Grants. **Courses added after 5/20/21 are NOT included for Pell Grants.** You are encouraged to register for all classes by 5/20/21 to maximize eligibility for aid.

INITIAL REGISTRATION OR FAFSA RECEIVED AFTER 5/20/21: If you initially register *after* 5/20/21 OR EFSC receives your FAFSA after 5/20/21, EFSC will recalculate your Pell Grant once you have registered for any part of term **AND** EFSC has received your FAFSA. **Any classes added AFTER this time are NOT included for Pell Grant.** If you initially register after 5/20/21, you are encouraged to register for all of your classes in one registration session instead of registering over multiple days to maximize eligibility for aid. IF YOU ARE CHANGING YOUR MAJOR, DO NOT REGISTER UNTIL YOUR NEW MAJOR IS REFLECTED IN myGPS.

150% PELL GRANT: If you received a full-time Pell Grant in both Fall 2020 and Spring 2021, you must attend at least 6 hours required for your program of study at EFSC to receive a Pell Grant in Summer 2021.
