**How to obtain credit for industry certification**


***No later than three years after obtaining the certification, or with approval from the Director of aviation Programs student must:***

1. Be an active student in good standing at EFSC, currently enrolled in one of the programs listed above. Student's major must reflect this program.
2. Satisfy all admissions requirements.
3. Successfully complete EFSC credits as specified above with the criteria below:  
 THE COURSE AMT 2930 ACKNOWLEDGES ARTICULATION CREDITS FOR THOSE STUDENTS WHO PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF THE AIRCRAFT AIRFRAME MECHANIC AND AIRCRAFT POWERPLANT MECHANIC PSAV/CTC PROGRAM(S) AND ARE ENROLLED IN THE AVIATION MAINTENANCE ADMINISTRATION DEGREE.  
 OR  
 FOR THOSE STUDENTS WHO PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION AND HAVE AN ACTIVE STATUS FOR THE FAA MECHANIC CERTIFICATION WITH AIRFRAME AND POWERPLANT RATINGS.
4. Student must complete 25% of the degree requirements through traditional coursework at EFSC.
5. Upon completion of the above requirements, student must submit the *Petition for Articulated Credit* form, along with a legible copy of the certificate, through the Office of Career and Technical Programs to the Office of the Registrar, CO Bldg 2-020, 1519 Clearlake Rd, Cocoa, FL 32922.
6. Industry certification must not be expired at the time credit is requested.

Address questions regarding this agreement to the appropriate EFSC program representative, the EFSC Office of Career and Technical Programs, or the EFSC Office of the Registrar. This agreement shall be reviewed every two years and will remain in effect until revoked or terminated by the College.


